

Parents and Students I would like to once again formally introduce the 2010-2011 SCPS Dress Code. As I have said before, please take the time to review this before you make those summer shopping outings for school clothing.

General Information:

Responsibility for the dress and appearance of students enrolled in Seminole County Public Schools primarily rests with parents and the students. Some student apparel, however, may not be appropriate to wear to school.

The School Board has established the following minimal guidelines:

- Standards of appearance shall insure that the students be clean, neat, and properly dressed.
- Students should dress appropriately to be successful in the academic environment.
- It is the responsibility of the Principal to see that the dress appearance of any students shall not be extreme, create a disturbance or is not hazardous to oneself, others or school property.
- The Principal or his/her designee has the final authority for interpreting whether a student's apparel/appearance conforms to the dress code.

The following information is proposed to help clarify the Seminole County Public School Dress Code for 2010-2011.
